Dear Parent/Guardian(s):

As we begin our final term, we would like to remind you of the following information.

Our next report card will be the final one in June. The Ministry of Education requires that all courses have a 30% exam and/or culminating activity towards the end of a course.

If your son or daughter is required to do a culminating activity for a course, all of the work for this evaluation must be done during class time and under teacher supervision.

Your son or daughter will receive an outline of each culminating activity and a copy of our Culminating Activities Calendar which can be used to plan and organize workload. You may access the CAC on the school website at www.rhsa.ca.

If your son or daughter is required to do an exam for a course, this exam will take place between June 15 and June 21, 2018. Exam timetables will be distributed to students in May.

All absences from culminating activities or exams require a medical note. This note must specifically state that your son or daughter was too ill to be at school on the required day.

It is important that you not schedule early vacations or other summer activities before June 23rd. Attendance is critical during this period of evaluation.


The Final Report card marks are based on:

70% - Term Mark (this includes any December exams weighted at 10%)

30% - Final Exam and/or Culminating Activity
