 - ◆ For Visual Arts, a maximum of 3 samples of art work may be submitted. These samples should not be larger than 8 ½ X 11, must be attached and may include copies or photos of sketches, paintings, drawings, etc. Please DO NOT send originals as we are unable to return them. Photos of 3-dimensional work are also permitted but CDs or videos will not be accepted.
 - ◆ You may bring your portfolio to your interview.
- Two (2) **pieces of identification** (*including birth certificate or passport*)
- One **Optional Attendance Form** (Note: the Lottery Process DOES NOT apply to RHSA)

All applicants will be notified of their admission status by Friday, February 15th, 2019. Qualified applicants will be contacted for an interview and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian if under 18 years of age.
